The Ossolineum is one of the largest scientific libraries in Poland, second to none as far as the collections in the field of the humanities are concerned. The acquisitions profile has been defined as humanistic with special stress being laid on Polish and Slavonic history, culture and literature. In this respect, the Ossolineum collections are unique not only in Poland but also worldwide.

The Ossolineum is a presence library and the items collected are available on-site only in eight reading rooms.

The institution has decided to create a museum for its collections linked with Polish Romanticism. It will be located in a registered historical site, i.e. the main square of Wrocław. The Museum of Romanticism does not only aim at demonstrating the influence of Romanticism on Polish culture and history, but also at becoming a new tourist attraction.
